- Only completed draft papers will be considered for the conference. All abstracts will be subjected to double-blind review by at least two reviewers.
- Acceptance of submission will be based on: Theme or title, Originality, Clarity, Relevance, and Contribution. Posters in specific areas are encouraged.
- iii. Practitioners should submit their presentations based on practical experiences one month before the conference (6<sup>th</sup> September, 2022).
- iv. All papers should be written in English.
- v. The text should be single-spaced, 12 font size, Times New Roman font, maximum of 20 pages including references (Harvard style), tables, and figures.
- vi. All papers will be published in the conference proceedings.
