Please be informed that, you have been selected to join the National College of Tourism to pursue the

Your actual admission will be subject to accepting and fulfilling the following conditions:

1. REGISTRATION

During registration you are required to bring;-

- a. ORIGINAL and CERTIFIED COPIES of Academic and Birth Certificates,
- b. One recent identical stamp size photographs for your file.
- c. A sealed medical examination report from a recognized Government Hospital.
- d. A Verification Code from NACTVET
- e. Fee payment slip

NOTE: NON-CERTIFIED COPIES of certificates will not be accepted.

2. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Admission to the College is conditional upon a satisfactory medical report being received by the College. You are therefore required to undergo a medical examination (See attached Form) by a registered Medical Doctor before coming to the College.

3. ACCOMODATION

The College has few hostels to accommodate students, however the College can recommend accomodation facilities found around the Campuses during registration.

4. TUITION FEES AND OTHER PAYMENTS
